An /n/ at the end of a syllable, when it is not the last sound in a word, is commonly not written, as in the following:

W After Consonants

A /w/ that occurs after a consonant, as in **ikwe**, 'woman,' is factored out and placed after the resulting syllabic for Western and before it for Eastern, as in the following examples:

Indicating Vowel Length (Pointed Syllabics)

To indicate a long vowel in a syllable, you can place a dot over its syllabic. Note that dots are not used with e-syllabics, since there is no contrasting short vowel.

Indicating Strong vs. Weak Consonants (Pointed Syllabics)

To indicate a syllable beginning with a strong consonant (p, t, k, s, sh), you can place the symbol for 'h' (or glottal stop) before it, as in the following:
